Last Round !

Here we are! The countdown is on and we are going full speed ahead in the latest month before the race. The summer break allowed us to rest, to make the last tests (especially with the presence of our Godfather Mathieu Baumel) and to finalize the last modifications on the buggy. These allow us to be in accordance with the regulations that we have to follow on this rally. On the logistics side now, we are in the process of reserving everything in order to leave nothing to chance:



- Transportation of the Tigers: Velaux (France) - Almeria (Spain) - Nador (Morocco) - Zagora (Morocco) RT
- Accommodation during the round trip and on base camp in Zagora (Morocco) during the rally
- Customs papers for the boat from Almeria to Nador
- Vehicle passport for the buggy for customs and the race
- Organization around the Covid, tests to be planned, health pass and other papers to enter Morocco
- Preparation of all the spare parts and tools that we will need for the race, etc.



Last minute information from the organization: From Almeria where we will take the boat reserved for rally participants, we will be and remain in a sanitary bubble until we return to Almeria. Boat privatized by the organization, convoy from Nador to Zagora then it will be forbidden to go out of base camp or having interactions with the outside residents of Morocco when we arrive at base camp. Same thing for the return. It pains us a bit but that was the condition for the rally to take place this year...
